 - Dialysis Beds: 4
- Registrar

Renal Laboratory

- Essential
- A Part of Ward Corridor partitioned as Renal Laboratory
- Tests to be set up:
 - Phase contrast microscopy
 - **⇔** GFR
 - Tubular function Concentration, acidification
 - Renal biopsy:
 - Doing biopsy
 - Processing biopsy
 - Reporting biopsy
- Problems:
 - No Laboratory Staff
 - No Laboratory Equipment

- Hospital gave Renal Department one Laboratory Staff Member
- Cummings:
 - Became friends
 - Mark Invited Service Club Presidents to a Meeting with Renal Physician
 - Asked Service Clubs to raise money to fund requirements that Hospital Administration could not fund

- Major contribution at International Symposium on Pyelonephritis Vesico-Ureteric Reflux and Renal Papillary Necrosis, RMH March 1970
- Major contribution in getting Government to ban APC Powders in Australia
