About the Trans-catheter Aortic Valve Implantation (TAVI) Clinic ✓

1. Check criteria ✓

Criteria

- Patients aged from 60 years with:
 - moderate to severe aortic stenosis
 - an echocardiograph of AV MG > 35 mmHg or AVA < 1 cm² within the last 6 months
- Patients with symptomatic worsening heart failure, recurrent angina, or syncope are given priority over patients whose symptoms are being managed and will be seen more urgently.

3. Confirm that a transfer of care is consistent with the patient's wishes ✓.

4. Prepare the required information ✓

Required information

In addition to the [standard referral information](#) ✓, provide:

- Relevant cardiac investigations including ECG, stress test, or echocardiogram within the last 6 months
- Expected outcome from the consultation
- Indication of urgency to facilitate appropriate triaging

5. Refer using SeNT eReferral (preferred) or fax a written referral addressed to Dr Rohan Bhagwandeem
